Here are a few tips for a great interview:

1. Introduce yourself, let them know your name and remind them why you're calling.
2. Let them know that you are recording the call.
3. Speak slowly & clearly so that they can understand you. You may be asked to repeat yourself- that's okay!
4. Ask them to speak slowly so you have time to write down your notes.
It might help to record your conversation, but ask for permission at the beginning of your call.
5. Remember, you don't have to take down what they say word for word!
Just give us a good sense of what they said & a few quotes if you can.
6. At the end of the call you can chat about an artistic project that you could work on together to be included in the time machine!
